

## **Update on the Oral Hearing for the Proposed Two incinerators in Ringaskiddy**

An Bord Pleanála has decided to hold an Oral Hearing in relation to the Toxic and Municipal incinerators proposed for Ringaskiddy.

It starts on Monday, 27th April 2009, at 11am, at The Cork International Airport Hotel, Cork.

Your attendance through-out, but particularly on the 27<sup>th</sup>, would be very welcome and important so as to show how much the community are opposed to this facility.

Anyone who put in a submission is entitled to speak at the Oral Hearing which will probably run for two weeks. See information on [www.chaseireland.org](http://www.chaseireland.org).

Those in CHASE who will spend their time at the Oral Hearing do so voluntarily, putting aside family and work to try and ensure that this community will not be burdened with a facility that we know will damage our health and environment.

Your support is most important and sends a clear message that we care about where we live. It is important that people come along and express their viewpoint on this developer driven project.

The only people proposing incineration or who say there is no danger from it, are those who are paid by the incineration industry. There wasn't one letter of support for Indaver Ireland's proposal in the submissions, which can be viewed in Count Hall by any member of the public

The Oral Hearing will cost a lot of money, which is an additional burden on the community and will have to be raised within the community at a very difficult economic time. To kick start this we are organising a **Plant and Cake Sale in Carrigaline Community Centre on 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> of May.**

All you keen gardeners who are currently pruning and thinning please pot up your excess and donate to the fund raiser. Young plants from seedlings of herbs and summer bedding would also be very welcome.
