

Re: Waste to Energy Facility, Ringaskiddy, Co. Cork.

Dear Madam,

I refer to the additional information received by An Bord Pleanála in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the above mentioned proposed development. Please be advised that An Bord Pleanála considers that this additional information contains significant additional data in relation to the effects on the environment of the proposed development and it therefore requires you in accordance with sub-section 2(b) of 37F of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended to:

- (a) publish in one or more newspapers circulating in the area in which the proposed development would take place a notice stating that significant additional information in relation to the said effects has been furnished to An Bord Pleanála, that the additional information will be available, for inspection or for purchase (upon payment of a specified fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy), at a specified place and at specified times during a specified period, and that submissions or observations in relation to the additional information may be made in writing to An Bord Pleanála before a specified date, and update the stand-alone website stating that the additional information can be downloaded, and
- (b) send notice of the furnishing to An Bord Pleanála of significant additional information and a copy of the additional information, to the planning authority and to the prescribed bodies stating that submissions or observations in relation to the additional information may be made in writing to An Bord Pleanála before a specified date.

In respect of (a) above the notices should be published in the same newspapers in which notices of the original application was advertised and the additional information should be made available for inspection or purchase at the same locations at which the original application documentation was available. In respect of the time limits for the making of submissions or observations in relation to the additional information to An Bord Pleanála under (a) and (b) above please indicate the specified time limit for the receipt of submissions to be **not later than 5.30 p.m. on the 21st July, 2017 in both cases** (to allow six weeks for submissions).

You should submit the relevant newspaper notices and a copy of any notices issued under (b) above to the Board as soon as same are available.

Your response to this letter should be received not later than 5.30 p.m. on Friday 16th June, 2017.

Notice of Significant Additional Information in Relation to a Direct Planning Application to An Bord Pleanála in Respect of a Strategic Infrastructure Development

An Bord Pleanála Reference Number PL 04.PA0045

County Cork

In accordance with Section 37E of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 as inserted by the Planning and Development (Strategic Infrastructure) Act, 2006 and amended by the Planning & Development (Amendment) Act, 2010 and the Environment (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2011, Indaver Ireland made an application to An Bord Pleanála on the 13th January 2016 for:

A 10-year planning permission and a 30-year operational life from the completion of the construction of the proposed development, is sought for a Waste to Energy Facility (waste incinerator with energy recovery) for the treatment of non-hazardous and hazardous waste on a 13.55-hectare site owned by Indaver Ireland at Ringaskiddy, County Cork.

The proposed redevelopment was fully described in the original public notice for the application.

The significant additional information in relation to the effects on the environment of the proposed development was lodged with An Bord Pleanála on the 15th May 2017.

This significant additional information, together with the original planning application, may be inspected free of charge or purchased on payment of a specified fee during public opening hours **for a period of six weeks** commencing on the **2**nd **June 2017** at the following locations:

- The Offices of Cork County Council, Planning Department, County Hall, Carrigrohane Road, Cork, T12 R2NC.

Submissions or observations in relation to the significant additional information may be made only to An Bord Pleanála ('the Board'), 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin, D01 V902 during the above-mentioned period of six weeks relating to:

- (i) the implications of the proposed development for proper planning and sustainable development, and
- (ii) the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, if carried out.

(iii) the likely effects on a European site of the proposed development if carried out, (if applicable).

Any submissions/observations must be accompanied by a fee of €50 (except for certain prescribed bodies). There is no fee required to make a submission in relation to those parties/individuals who have already made a valid written submission to the Board regarding the application. Submissions or observations must be received by the Board not later than 5.30 p.m. on the 14th July 2017. Such submissions/observations must also include the following information:

- the name of the person making the submission or observation, the name of the person acting on his or her behalf, if any, and the address to which any correspondence relating to the application should be sent,
- the subject matter of the submission or observation, and
- the reasons, considerations and arguments on which the submission or observation is based in full.

Any submissions or observations which do not comply with the above requirements cannot be considered by the Board.

A person may question the validity of any such decision by the Board by way of an application for judicial review under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986), in accordance with section 50 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended.
